












## Bila Tserkva Center contribution to SCES personnel training



In total the Center has trained more than 35 thousands of Ukrainian penitentiary service staff, including 33 categories of positions by 60 different training programs



## Introduction online (distant) form of training for penitentiary staff



- ✓ In 2019 the Center provided distant training for **350** probation bodies employees and in the first half of 2020 for **250** persons.
- ✓ Because of Covid-19 pandemic situation, training in the second half of 2020 is being carried out remotely and in distant-day time form for 953 employees. To ensure this the Center has developed 18 e-learning courses on the Moodle platform.


